#### **Treasurer's Report:**

- During 2015-2016 we raised over \$100,000 (gross)
- 2016-2017 budget has been developed based on last year's expenditures and collected income- largest allocation is \$25,000 to support district-wide cultural enrichment & field trips
- Each school has been allocated \$500 to use for refreshments/materials for celebrations, after-school & end-of-year activities as well as for dances that are not PTO-sponsored. Ha will give each principal \$500 cash, but they are still required to submit the financial assistance form 2 weeks prior to using the funds to purchase items, and then submit receipts once the purchases have been made. Ha is currently trying to obtain tax-exempt cards for stores most often used for purchases.

#### **New Business:**

- Class Parent Program- Pilot program at Woodside & Oakside- parent recruitment done through letters mailed home as well as sign ups at Back-to-School nights, goal is to facilitate communication between PTO & schools and expand our reach with parent volunteers, orientation sessions will take place at both schools (go over district's volunteer policy & form, identify monthly PTO and/or school-based activities that parents can assist with (Isabel will provide Jen her compiled list of events/activities), based on feedback from principals program may now also be implemented this year at Uriah Hill and Hillcrest
- Passive Fundraising- All schools agreed to provide PTO with funds raised from box tops (Exception Oakside b/c teachers coordinate) and Stop & Shop A+ Rewards. Marisa will draft a MOU that principals and PTO can sign off on & then submit to Robin Zimmerman in business office so it is clear that even though the district will be receiving the money, it should be funneled to the PTO
