# <u>Guest Presentation- Mr. John Laplaca from Altaris Consulting Group (k – 12 safety & security management):</u>

- Peekskill district wants to ensure the safety of all students & therefore reached out to Altaris to help train all staff on safety & security protocols
- Altaris was asked to review the visitor management systems at each building-district is in a good place with its current protocols
- Staff development- team spent a full day going into each building working with the district emergency response teams, training on prevention/threat assessment
- Currently working on revising almost all emergency response plans
- Will be conducting table top exercises

- Parents role in an emergency: if you see something, say something (at building or district level; can be done anonymously, communicate to kids signs of aggression and/or depression), listen to instructions given by district (i.e. do not drive to your child's school to pick him/her if you have been instructed not to)
- Any entities within 10 mile radius of Indian Point required to have an emergency evacuation plan
- Rare occurrence when an entire district must be evacuated
- District is required to have mental health protocols in place
