Items Requiring Discussion:

- **Screenagers Documentary:** After several discussions with the filmmaker and her team, the PTO will be able to acquire the license to screen the documentary at no cost. Additionally, we will be able to participate in the launch of a new program backed by a grant from Melinda Gates. We are one out of only 25 schools nationwide to be selected to participate. As part of the program, we will be issued \$400 to be used toward refreshments and/or childcare. The PTO will also receive printed materials for distribution at no cost (marketing and discussion documents). Dates for the general and student screening must be finalized ASAP. A determination regarding the target student audience must also be made because we will only be able to provide a screening to a single group of students.

Items for Information Only:

- **Parents' Time Out:** Held on 2/11/17 at PKMS from 3:30-6:30pm. The Vue Restaurant, Beanrunner Cafe and Taco Dive Bar graciously partnered with us to offer participating parent a discount on their meal during the event. There were 29 students pre-registered and an additional 4 students registered the day of the event. In total, 28 students participated and \$185 in donations was collected. Disclaimer: Volunteers were not required to make a donation.
- **Emergency Preparedness Prep Rally:** Woodside, Oakside and Hillcrest POCs have been given hard copy information for their review. Follow-up meetings will be scheduled to outline age appropriate activities and viable June dates. Community outreach is forthcoming.
- **Lip Sync Battle:** No further communication with the Performing Art Department has been made due to scheduling conflicts. The Special Event Committee Liaison has reached out to Mr. Lewis for assistance in assessing student interest to participate in such an event. We are considering using a brief Google survey since the students are currently using the Google Classroom platform. Further review of this event will follow.
