President's Report:

Treasurer's Report:

- Building Allocations for PTO funds: \$500 for Elementary schools and \$750 for PKMS and PHS
- Funds will be given in \$100 increments, after the first installment, Financial Assistance Request form along with receipts for money spent must be given to PTO treasurer and next \$100 will be given at that time.
- Fundraising initiatives: Direct Appeal; School photos; spirit gear (blow-out sales at back to school nights for last year's stock); Book Fairs; Art to Remember at Woodside, Oakside, and Hillcrest; Stop and Shop A+ Rewards (ongoing); possible Read-a-Thon (Elementary Principals will advise if this is feasible)

New Business:

- Oct. 18th, General Meeting/PTO Kick off: Officers will be introduced, Committee Chairs will speak about their respective Committees; Marisa will invite Boy/Girl Scouts and the Youth Bureau to attend and speak; HRH will provide Zumba for the kids in attendance
- Walk Like MADD: Event/Walk is Oct. 20th, more community involvement is needed. Register Teams on PTO website homepage
- Back to School Nights: PTO will have a table with Peekskill Swag for sale as well as info on PTO
- PEF (Peekskill Education Foundation) has reorganized and will be looking for ways to raise money for our district in the near future
- Uriah Hill received a grant which will allow a full day class with 12 spaces for new students; Meet the Teacher Night is Sep 24th.
- Woodside: Kindergarten Concierge and First Grade Front Desk helped make the first day back to school a big success with parents and students alike. Meet the Teacher Nights are Sep. 17th and Oct 10th.
- Oakside: Theme for the year, "Reading takes you out of this world." Meet the Teacher nights are Sep. 25th and 26th.
- Hillcrest: New homework requirements for this year are reading every night and practicing math facts tailored to what the child needs. A new program called WIN (What I Need) where groups of students go to a teacher who is an expert in an area where the student needs help during a set time period every day.
- PKMS: Instituted a new tardiness policy to eliminate lateness and students missing their first class. Meet the Teacher Night is Oct. 3rd.
- PHS: Senior College Night is Sep 20th. There will be a college fair at BOCES, busing will be provided for the students. PHS open house will be Sep 27th.
- Dads take your kids to school initiative was successful in the entire district.

Committee Reports:

- Advocacy: Will continue Foundation Aid work: Social Media Campaign for fully funded schools; Starting a Community outreach committee; Will run Meet the Candidate Forum for School Board elections in the spring
- Class Parents: Orientation meeting Oct 24th; Sign-ups at Meet the Teacher nights; 2 parents per class is ideal
- **Communications:** Volunteers are requested to make copies at the Administration Building during the School Day
- **Special Events/Enrichment:** Trunk or Treat will be on Oct. 27th from 1-3pm in the Admin Bldg. parking lot; will again piggy-back the Safe Trick-or-treat event at PHS (11-1pm), an email regarding sign-ups for trunks, helpers, candy donations and game coordinators will be sent in the near future

Superintendent's Report:

- The district is working with UHC, will eventually donate funds to PTO; Working on Pre-K grant to fund a full day of Pre-K and allow more children to attend Pre-K at Uriah Hill
- Maria Flores is the liaison for Parent Center; District is looking for a new location (possible multiple locations) for Parent Center
- Update on Community Schools: Saturday Academy to be held at PKMS on Oct. 27th

BOE update:

- Board has requested more parents to attend Board Meetings; also, requested PTO to come to the board as *parents* if there are issues. Chances are other people are having the same issues. This may facilitate getting the issue on the agenda of the Board meeting.
