The goal of participation is meaningful dialogue for parents and relationships with school leaders. Parents not on the PTO executive board will have space to provide input through this function. Each school should be represented on the PTO executive board if execs are not already linked with a school building. **\*\*Raine is the point person** for this project as of tonight's meeting. She will coordinate with David to develop the structure and find site coordinators. **Eric's wife, Tricia Schultz** - offered to work on parent involvement in Woodside or Hillcrest schools.

<u>Department of Health Update</u>: mask mandate, weekly testing for staff, exception fully vaccinated may choose to opt out of weekly testing

County dept of health: 2 types of testing, we signed up for Gateway Testing (test as many students as possible) and Surveillance Testing (test 20% of students, staff, teachers weekly). Testing delayed as testing facility ramps up (Brooklyn based). Testing in-school or send test home and bring sample back to school, collected and brought to the lab in Brooklyn
